SFEEF will award a \$1000 scholarship to a male graduating senior & a \$1000 scholarship to a female graduating senior who exemplify character, integrity, academic success, and a sense of community. Scholarship awards are made directly to the post-secondary institution.

To qualify you must:

- * Be a graduating senior from Spanish Fort High School
- * Have a minimum grade point average 2.7 on a 4.0 scale
- * Participate in voluntary community service
- * Submit an essay
- * Include two letters of recommendation –one from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator and one from non-school personnel (not a family member) in **sealed envelopes** in your scholarship packet. Packet must include all documents. Do not staple nor use pencil in submitting this application.
