

# 2023 Clemons-Imle Leadership School Seniors

## To qualify you must:

- \* Be a graduating senior from Spanish Fort High School
- \* Have a minimum grade point average 2.7 on a 4.0 scale
- \* Participate in voluntary community service
- \* Submit an essay
- \* Include two letters of recommendation —one from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator and one from non-school personnel (not a family member) in **sealed envelopes** in your scholarship packet. Packet must include all documents. Do not staple nor use pencil in submitting this application.
